Signs of infection could also include pain in the abdomen, pelvis, legs, back, or bladder Call your healthcare provider if you have these symptoms Handling the bag and tube Be careful to not introduce germs into the catheter and to make sure the urine can flow steadily into the bag • Keep the bag below the level of your bladder

Bladder Dysfunction in Parkinson's Disease

- Most common type in Parkinson's disease
- Faulty signals from the bladder to the brain as is seen in nerve problems This is common in diabetes
- Inability of the brain or spinal cord to control bladder contractions Very common in various neurological conditions such as spinal cord injury, multiple sclerosis, Parkinson's disease

3 sitting in a bathtub of warm water (unless incision could get wet) 4 sitting or standing in a warm shower (unless incision could get wet) 5 thinking about waterlake, stream, ocean, etc 6 placing a warm and wet towel on your stomach or back 7 Straining to urinate may not help, in fact, may hinder urination Try to relax as best possible
