#### **4.4.2 Amphibian and Reptile Survey Protocol**

Sampling for reptiles and amphibians is relatively safe; however, some basic precautions should be taken It is valuable to have knowledge of first aid and to have directions and contact information for emergency health care Poison oak/stinging nettle Learn to recognize poison oak and stinging nettle before going out into the field Wearing

#### **Thin Skinned Amphibians**

Salamanders, like all amphibians, have skin that is thinner than the skin of other animals This allows for a high level of oxygen to exchange with the blood vessels that are close to the surface of the skin This is called “permeable skin” and amphibian skin is much more permeable than other vertebrates such as birds, mammals or reptiles
